MEMORANDUM FOR INSTRUCTION/INTENT TO PLAY

SUBJECT: 2018 Over - 30 Basketball Program

- 1. **GENERAL**: The Fort Gordon Over 30 Basketball Program will be conducted during the period of April-May 2018. The league is designed for individuals seeking a recreational outlet that have reached the age of thirty (30) not later than 1 March 2018. It is not intended as a highly competitive league, but is designed to supplement the fitness and recreational needs in a particular age group.
- 2. **ORGANIZATION**: Teams will be composed of active, retired military personnel, their family members and Fort Gordon civilian employees meeting the age limitations outlined in paragraph 1. Registration will be accepted on a continuing basis after the registration cut-off date of 29 March 2018. Late registrations will be placed on a stand-by list and will be added according to the team requirements for replacements based upon age and height and not according to date of registration. Teams will be organized by the Sports Office and structured according to age/height. League play will consist of Round Robin with a Post Season Tournament including all teams in the league. All participants must attend an organization meeting on 29 March 2018 at 1800 hrs. The meeting will be held in the Sports Office (Bldg. 24501).

3. **RESPONSIBILITIES**:

- a. Sports Director: Responsible to Directorate of Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation (DFMWR) for planning, organizing, scheduling, implementation and overall supervision of the Over 30 League.
- b. Team POC's: Responsible to the Sports Coordinator to notify the Sports Office when additional players are required due to dropouts, extended TDY's, failure to participate, etc. Coordinate with gym facilities for practice time. Disseminate pertinent information provided by the Sports Office. Ensure only players assigned in writing participate in the league.
- c. Team Participants: Responsible to the Team POC to ensure that sufficient players are available for all scheduled games. Ensure the POC is notified when participation cannot be accomplished due to military commitments, extended TDY's etc.

4. PROCEDURES AND RULES:

- a. Games will be played according to the 2018 National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) Basketball Rules with the following additional/amended rules:
- b. Game time is forfeit time. All teams must be on the floor ready to play at the scheduled time. Failure to do so will result in a forfeit.
- c. Teams forfeiting two games for failure to play at the scheduled time will be dropped from the league including tournament play.
- d. All team members must wear a uniformed jersey of like color and design. Uniforms may be picked up by the Team's POC at the Outdoor Maintenance/Supply Office (Bldg 24501), prior to the first scheduled game.
 - e. No cancellations will be accepted and no games will be rescheduled.
- f. Players ejected from a game for unsportsmanlike conduct will be suspended for one (1) game. A player ejected from the game for unsportsmanlike conduct a second time during the season will be suspended for the remainder of the playing season, to include tournament games. A player who is detected participating in any manner during suspended period by any member of the Sports Staff, an Official or Opposing Player will automatically be suspended from further participation for the remainder of the season and the offending team will forfeit all games in which the suspended player participated.
 - g. The rule pertaining to playing time is amended as follows:
- (1) Each game shall consist of two (2) halves, running clock of twenty (20) minutes each with a five (5) minute halftime. The clock will stop only for time-outs and unnecessary delays, except for the last two (2) minutes of the second half when the clock is stopped according to NCAA published rule.
- (2) Overtime periods will be three (3) minutes duration, the clock operating according to the published NCAA rule.
- h. Protests will be accepted for ineligibility only and must be submitted in writing not later than 1600 the next scheduled duty day to the Sports Office (Bldg 24501).
- i. All games will be played on the date indicated by the playing schedule. The second team listed on the schedule is the home team and will sit on the right side of the official scorer.
- 5. **TROPHIES**: Team trophies will be presented to the first, second, and third place teams. Individual trophies will be presented to the first and the second place teams in the post season tournament play only.
