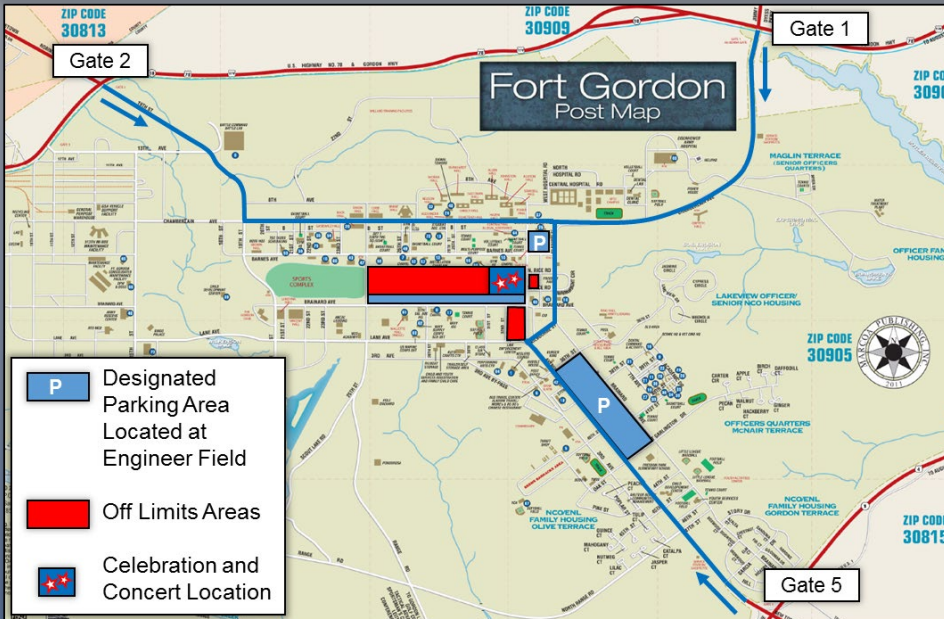


INDEPENDENCE CELEBRATION

PROHIBITED ITEMS:

- ☐ Outside food or beverages to include any alcohol
- ☐ Coolers of any size
- ☐ Tents, canopies and large sunshades
- ☐ Grills or other open flames
- ☐ Pets (Service animals authorized)
- ☐ Large bags exceeding 16x16x8 inches (Only clear bags are authorized)
- ☐ Glass containers
- ☐ Weapons of any kind (Knives, multi-tools; weapons carried with permit are also prohibited)
- ☐ Personal fireworks, sparklers, and explosives
- ☐ Toy guns (including water guns) / knives / swords
- ☐ Laser pointers or devices
- ☐ Cameras with zooming lenses
- ☐ Artificial noise makers (i.e. Air horns, cowbells, etc.)

All persons, bags, and items will be searched



All vehicles and persons are subject to search upon entering Fort Gordon.

Gates 1 and 5 will be open for public access from 5:00 pm to 9:00 pm. Gate 2 will be open for ONLY DoD ID Card holders from 5:00 pm to 9:00 pm. Gate 5 and 2 will be open for outbound until midnight.

Handicap parking is available on a first come, first serve basis directly south of Barton Field.



Field Evacuation Procedures

In case of inclement weather you will be instructed to return to your vehicle. Once the all clear is given the Independence Celebration will continue.

For serious inclement weather you will be instructed to go to one of the 4 identified locations (green) on the map to the right. You will proceed to shelter in place until the all clear is given. Please follow all instructions from event staff and law enforcement.
