The CARE Team, activated by the Battalion Commander or Rear Detachment Commander, is designed to assist a Family when a trauma in the unit occurs. The purpose of the CARE Team is to offer short-term care and support to Families of deceased and seriously wounded Soldiers/Civilians until the Family's own support structure is in place. The CARE Team will ONLY be utilized at the request of the Family and should not be assumed to be needed in all traumatic events. CARE Teams are not mandatory, but are an additional way battalions can provide valuable support to Families.
